<u>Global Goals Centre</u> (GGC) creates engaging experiences to inspire learning and action on climate, nature and equality in our everyday lives, inspired by the <u>Sustainable Development Goals</u>, through schools workshops and interactive projects.

The charity is funded by a mixture of sponsorship, grant funding and project funding; it aims to become more sustainable financially by securing more longer term grants if possible.

Job role

- Lead on GGC fundraising strategy
- Research funding options for Global Goals Centre and Sparks
- Write funding applications and advise on application deadlines
- Create project budgets and adapt as needed for different applications
- Keep a comprehensive record of applications made
- Keep a record of reporting needed and submit feedback to funders
- Developing partnerships with funders, like-minded organisations and high net worth individuals
- Understanding and supporting the aims of GGC and Sparks

Expected skills and experience

- At least 2 years of trusts and foundations fundraising for charities or CICs
- Ability to self-manage
- Experience of compiling income, expenditure and project budgets

Target

£100,000 per year in grants and donations for the charity
